We had 140 businesses leaders attend our January monthly breakfast. It was the highest attendance of a breakfast meeting in the history of the chamber; we want to thank St. Joseph Medical Center and Dr. Smyth, President/CEO for sponsoring the event and for the wonderful presentation.

The following topics were also discussed;

- Major Dee Chemili, Captain Sam Houston and Detective Jimmy Waites, LBGTQI+ Liaison talked about community safety and how it is being addressed.
- BG&E gave a presentation about the construction of new gas pipelines in Towson. If you would like to contact BGE concerning this project please let us know.
- New Members: Panda Express- Rachel Razo, Aveley Farms Coffee- Corey Voelkel, A. Hoffman Awning Company- Jim Healy, Raising Cane's- Mike Kearns, Wonderfly Events LLC- Aaron Smith, Dogtopia of Towson- Alex Davis, and School of Rock Baltimore- Melody Easton.
- We welcomed Councilman Mike Ertel who shared that he's excited to work with the business community.
- Surveillance Cameras- we added cameras to over 50 businesses, so about 85% of the downtown core now has surveillance cameras.
- Grants and projects we are working on in 2023.
- Baltimore County & Greening Committee- dead trees are being removed and 100 trees are being planted.
- Design Review and Façade Improvement Committee chair John DiMenna we have applied for a
 façade improvement grant with the state for \$61,000, plus we can use the county's architect on
 call, which is up to \$10,000 per building
- Historic Walking Tour has been put together by John Holman which will include at least 14 sites.
- Calixta Eraso and the marketing committee will be putting together marketing and promotional materials for our community. She will also work with Emily Brophy to do a comprehensive business analyses for Towson. The chamber will work on getting funds to do the study.
- We also applied for a lighting grant for \$25,000, \$12,000 for murals, \$17,000 for sidewalk cleaning and \$10,000 in new plants and planters.
- Towson businesses Aveley Farms Coffee, Chatime Towson, Roggenart, The Sassy Skillet, and Dogtopia of Towson were all awarded the Project Restore Grant. Project Restore is providing financial support to Maryland's existing or new businesses to help incentivize commercial investment in vacant retail and commercial properties.


