# To: Baltimore County Retailers Re: Updates on Baltimore County's Bring Your Own Bag Law and Single-Use Plastic Checkout Bag Ban

Dear Retailer,

Starting November 1, 2023, Baltimore County will prohibit the distribution of single-use plastic checkout bags at the point of sale in order to reduce the significant negative impact of plastic bag litter in our communities, waterways and at the County's recycling processing plant.

In accordance with the bipartisan Bring Your Own Bag Act, the majority of retail establishments, including any store, food service facility and any other for-profit or non-profit establishment that provides paper or reusable bags to customers for the sale of goods. Retail establishments must charge a minimum of \$0.05 for each paper or reusable bag distributed.

Please take steps now so you will be ready when the law takes effect on November 1, 2023.

#### What retail establishments must comply?

Most retail establishments must comply, including grocery stores, restaurants, department stores, hardware and home improvement stores, pharmacies, liquor stores, and convenience stores.

#### What retail establishments are exempt?

Exempt locations include small retail establishments (stores, food service facilities or other establishments that provide carryout bags) that operate solely in Baltimore County or adjoining jurisdictions and have three or fewer locations and are not part of a franchise corporation, corporate control group or partnership with locations outside of Baltimore County and adjoining jurisdictions

This exemption <u>does not</u> apply to liquor stores, convenience stores, or fuel or service stations with convenience stores.

#### When does this take effect?

The Bring Your Own Bag law takes effect on November 1, 2023. During the first 90 days of implementation, (November 1, 2023 – January 29, 2024) the Baltimore County Department of Permits, Approvals and Inspections (PAI) will only issue correction notices with no monetary fines and will educate non-compliant establishments. After this 90-day grace period, fines will apply.

Additionally, the Director of PAI or designee may grant up to two waivers for a period of three additional months if the Director determines that compliance would cause an undue hardship or a practical difficulty not generally applicable to other retail establishments.
